Code of Conduct

- All patrons are expected to conduct themselves in a quiet, orderly manner that is respectful of other patrons and library staff.
- Mutilation, vandalism or theft of library materials or property is prohibited by law and may be prosecuted.
- Shirts, shoes and a reasonable level of personal hygiene are required.
- Running, roughhousing and using offensive language are prohibited.
- Use of any tobacco product or vaping is not allowed in the library or on library property.
- Children under the age of 7 must be attended by an adult.
- Loitering, soliciting, rollerblading and skateboarding are prohibited.
- Telephones are for staff and emergency use only.
- Excessive time in the rest rooms is prohibited.
- Any patron accompanied by a service or support animal will be instructed to leave the library if the animal: barks, growls or whimpers, is not housebroken, does not respond to commands, threatens or attempts to intimidate a staff members, patron or another animal. Animals left outside must be tied up and must not create a disturbance.
- Animals and bicycles must not block walkways or doorways.
- No commercial or media photography or filming of any type may occur in Library facilities without the prior written permission and approval of the Library Director.
